Release End-of-Semester Stress with OSHO Kundalini Meditation

The meditation is one hour long, with four stages: shaking, dancing, seated meditation and savasana. Being fully immersed in the shaking and dancing of the first two stages helps to "melt" the rock-like being, wherever the energy flow has been repressed and blocked. Then that energy can flow, dance and be transformed into bliss and joy.
