

University to host new student Discovery Day

Alfred University will host a Discovery Day for potential students on Saturday, April 28, 2007. The day will begin with registration from 8:30-9 a.m. at Powell Campus Center, a welcome from 9-9:15 in the Nevins Theater in Powell, followed by a parent-only session in Nevins and a student-only session in the Knight Club, both from 9:15-10. Following those sessions, there will be programs on academic interest presented in different areas of campus with math and science in the Board Room, engineering in Kenyon-Allen Room, visual arts in Nevins Theater, humanities and social sciences in the Knight Club, all in Powell Campus Center, and business in the lobby of Alumni Hall. All sessions run from 10-11:45 a.m. Then tours begin through Harder Hall, Binns-Merill and throughout the campus. There will also be sessions that are optional and these include a complimentary lunch at Ade Dining Hall and portfolio reviews and mini interviews at Alumni Hall, by appointment. The Alfred University Bookstore will also be open starting at 8:30 a.m. accepting coupons that came in the folders presented to students at registration.
