On Monday, Aug. 23, Sheila will present her work in Harder Hall Holmes Auditorium at 8:15 a.m. Then bring your crochet hook and join in any morning or afternoon in the Harder Foundations Studio. You will find more instructions there!

Sheila Pepe describes the process: "We will make a drawing, that is sculpture, that is also painting - by crafting, infesting, investing and imagining."

Her work has been shown in numerous solo exhibitions throughout the United States and is a recipient of the Joan Mitchell Foundation Award and the Louis Comfort Tiffany Foundation Award.

Pepe received a B.F.A. from the Massachusetts College of Art and a M.F.A. from the School of the Museum of Fine Arts/Tufts University in Boston.

In 1999 she moved to New York City where she currently lives and works as the Special Assistant to the Dean for Academic Affairs in the School of Art & Design at Pratt Institute.
