Employees should note that the mandatory base retirement contributions are listed in the informational Box 14 with the code of 403b or 414H. If you participate in a SRA or TDA, your elective contributions are in Box 12 with the code of E.

Safety tips for walking on ice

Please use extreme caution when traveling by foot or vehicle in and around the construction areas on campus. Pay special attention to the crosswalk area near the McMahon bldg. as well as the driveways

between Perlman Hall and Myers Hall and Powell Campus Center.
