## **AU men** s lacrosse team bows to Elmira in home finale 4/26/03

ALFRED Despite a dominating first period, the Alfred University men's lacrosse team lost 18-13 to Elmira College in the Saxons' season home finale. It looked as though Alfred (5-8, 2-5 Empire 8) would run away with the contest as the Saxons jumped out to a 7-0 lead after one period. Seni or midfielder Chris Burt (Horseheads/Williston-Northampton) netted four goals to pace Elmira. Junior midfielders Alexander Karoly (Brewster/Avon Old Farms) and Peter Whiteford (Cornwall/ Williston-Northampton), senior attack Andrew Slotnick (Marion, MA/W illiston-Northampton) and senior midfielder Scott McClelland (Canandaigua/Berkshire) each scored three times.
