

Tunisia is Topic of Global Awareness Program Wednesday at AU

Alfred, NY -- Tunisia: Past, Present, and Future is the subject of a Global Awareness Roundtable program set for 7 to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday (Feb. 16) at Alfred University. The program, in the Knight Club in Powell Campus Center, is free and open to the public. Talking about the African nation will be Zakia Robana, assistant professor of French; Abderrahman Robana, professor of business; and Meriam Djelidi, a freshman at AU. The three will cover topics such as history and geography, customs (clothing, food, weddings, henna, etc.), religious and ethnic diversity, Tunisias economic and political situation, women in Tunisia, art, architecture, education, and Carthage. The Global Awareness Roundtable is a monthly event, informal and friendly, designed to introduce the Alfred community to cultures around the world. The next two events are March 15 (the Philippines) and April 12 (India.)
