Recital Sunday features work by American composers 9/22/05

The Alfred University Music Department will open its "Guest Artist Series" with a recital by sopranos Luanne Crosby and Rebecca Weaver, accompanied by Laurel Buckwalter. The program, which begins at 3 p.m. in Howell Hall, will include much of the repertoire that the group performed in Varna, Bulgaria this past June. The recital focuses on American composers and features songs by Amy Beach, Samuel Barber, Richard Hundley, and Irving Fine.
