### Hornell YMCA Ooffers Self-Defense Class

The Hornell YMCA will offer a new self-defense class this fall. The class will be offered on Thursdays from 5 to 6 p.m. for 10 weeks starting Sept. 5 and concluding Nov. 7.

This self-defense class will be instructed by Sheriff David Cole. Sheriff Cole has over 30 years' experience in karate and is a 6th-degree black belt. He is also a former NYS Police defense tactics instructor and the current self-defense instructor for the Sheriff's CIRT (SWAT) team and the corrections CERT team.

This YMCA class will meet the needs of the community as it will teach techniques for self protection. The class will be designed to teach simple self-defense to defend against all types of single and multiple attacks. It will include very simple blocks, punches, strikes, kicks and stances, with each week developing on the week before.
