Financial Help for LGBTQ Students

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGBTQ) students seeking financial help for their incoming undergraduate or graduate school education can take action by applying for a Point Foundation Scholarship. Point is the nation's largest scholarship-granting organization for LGBTQ

students of merit.

To serve this population, Point Foundation has invested more than \$15 million in education and support of 243 scholars since 2001. Students who will be enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs for the 2014-5 academic year are eligible to apply. Applicants may submit Part I of the application until 11:59 p.m. PST on Jan. 21, 2014. Point will then invite qualified applicants to submit Part II of the application, which will remain so until 11:59 p.m. PST, Feb. 3, 2014.

The Allegany County Office for the Aging is looking for volunteers to help people with their tax returns. This is a great opportunity for people who like working with numbers, have experience in filing their own tax returns, and have some free time during the months of January (for training), February, March, and April.

The Tax Counseling for the Elderly Program (TCE) offers free income tax assistance for low to moderate income Allegany County residents. Volunteer Counselors are trained and certified to help people who are 60 and over with federal, state and local returns. Volunteers handle basic forms. If the client's return is more involved, the volunteer directs the person to go to a paid preparer. The training is in Belmont Jan. 13, 15, 17, 21, 22 and 24, 2014.
