New Printing System in the Libraries and Campus Computer Labs

Over the summer, the Libraries, ITS, and Office & Procurement Services have been working together to implement a new printing system in the libraries and in campus computer labs.

The new printing system will make it easier for students to print by sending their print jobs to a single print queue and then releasing the print job at any of nine public printers on campus.

Faculty and staff who print in the libraries will want to be aware of the new printing procedure. After sending an item to print, you will release it either by logging into the printer with your AU username and password, or by swiping a "key fob" at the printer.

For convenience, if you print regularly in the libraries, you will want to obtain a key fob from the mailroom in the Powell Campus Center. There is no charge for the key fob, but a \$5 fee will be charged for a replacement if the original key fob is lost.

Office and departmental printers are NOT affected by this change; it applies only to public printers in the libraries and in campus computer labs.

Russell Lecture

The speaker for this year's annual Russell Lecture in history is Barry Strauss, professor of history and classics at Cornell University. Strauss is a leading expert on ancient military history. His most recent book is "THE DEATH OF CAESAR" (2015).

The title of his lecture is: "The Death of Caesar: The Real Story of History's Most Famous Assassination." Thanks to Shakespeare, Julius Caesar's stabbing is the most famous assassination in history. But what actually happened in Rome on March 15, 44 B.C. is even more thrilling than the Bard's depiction. Strauss details the true story behind the carefully planned paramilitary operation executed by Caesar's disaffected officers.

The Russell Lecture will be held in Nevins Theater on Thursday, Sept. 10, 2015, from 7:30 - 9 p.m.

A reception will follow the lecture in the Alumni Lounge.

The Russell Lecture is free and open to the public.
