

## **Alfred University track & field teams wrap up State championship meet**

CANTON The Alfred University men's and women's track & field teams concluded the two day (Feb. 22, Feb. 23) New York State Collegiate Track Conference indoor track championship meet, which was held at St. Lawrence University's Newell Field house, on Saturday afternoon. The men's competition was won by host St. Lawrence (131 points), while RPI (114 points) finished second and Ithaca (76 points) third. The top spot in the women's competition was claimed by Ithaca (131 points), while St. Lawrence (128 points) and Hartwick (66 points) secured second and third place, respectively. The AU men's team ended the competition with a 12th place finish. Senior Chuck Compson (Newark/Midlakes), who placed fourth in the 55-meter high hurdles and senior Andy Corman (Rochester/Greece Athena), who claimed sixth place in the 3,000-meter run, highlighted Alfred's performance. Other top performers for AU included the 4x200 meter relay team of sophomore Nick Coleman, freshman Bill Levett (Syracuse/Westhill), freshman Casey Lesar (Mechanicsville, PA/Mechanicsville), and senior Chris Sabato (Pembroke/Notre Dame), who placed tenth in the event. The AU women's squad completed the two days of competition in 13th place. Senior Elizabeth Menter (Baldwinsville/C.W. Baker) took fourth in the weight throw to lead Alfred.
