The Alfred University chorus and concert band will combine to offer 'Festifall,' the annual pops concert, at 8 p.m. Friday (Nov. 4) in Holmes Auditorium, Harder Hall on the AU campus. The theme of this year's concert is "Songs of Protest, Songs of Peace," and will feature such selections as Simon and Garfinkle's "Scarborough Fair," "Sounds of Silence," and "Bridge Over Troubled Waters," as well as other memorable tunes by Crosby, Stills, Nash and Young, Tom Paxton and John Lennon. The songs "take you back to a time when young people were protesting the war in Viet Nam and crying for peace," according to the Division of Performing Arts newsletter.
