The Saxons (1-7, 0-0 Empire 8) came out very strong in the first half looking to avenge the disappointing loss to SUNY Potsdam the night before. After trailing by nine at the break, the Saxons started getting the ball into the paint and brought the game to within five a few times but could not close the gap.
