The AU men took fifth in both the giant slalom and slalom to place fifth overall out of seven teams competing. The Saxon women took seventh in the GS and fourth in the slalom and also finished fifth overall.

Freshman Holly Mager (Warsaw, NY/Warsaw) led the Alfred women in the giant slalom, taking 15th. Freshman Kaitlyn Tepper (Clifton Park, NY/Shenendehowa), junior Rebecca Spitz (Sterling, VA/Potomac Falls) and junior Dianne Mattar (East Amherst, NY/Williamsville East) were 22nd, 23rd and 24th, respectively.

Spitz was Alfred&s top women&s skier in the slalom, taking 16th, while senior Claire Dvorak (Tully, NY/Tully) was right behind in 17th.
