

Alfred University men's and women's Alpine ski teams compete at Swain

SWAIN, NY The Alfred University men's and women's Alpine ski teams competed at the AU-hosted races at Swain Ski Center over the weekend. The AU men's team placed first overall, while the women's team placed sixth. Senior Matt Seavey (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) led the AU men's team, placing first individually. He won the giant slalom and was second in the slalom. Alfred freshman Lincoln Steele (Keene, NH/Keene) was right behind, winning the slalom, placing second in the giant slalom and finishing second overall individually. Senior Jared Mostue (Hopkinton, NH/Proctor Academy) was fifth in the giant slalom, fourth in the slalom and finished fourth in the combined individual standings. Junior Anna Rung (Colden, NY/Springville) was the AU women's team's top skier, earning a 10th-place finish in the slalom while placing 21st in the giant slalom. Sophomore Laura La Pierre (Maplecrest, NY/Windham-Ashland-Jewett) was 23rd in the slalom, while junior Erin Knee (Jamestown, NY/Jamestown) was 24th in the slalom. The AU ski teams are in action next on Saturday and Sunday, Jan. 29 and 30, at the United State Collegiate Ski Association (USCSA) Mideast Conference crossover races at White Face Mountain. The crossover, which will include teams from the Mideast Conference's Empire Division and the Adirondack Division, is hosted by Clarkson University. Alfred University is a member of the Empire Division.
