

Brockport edges Saxons in men's lacrosse

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's lacrosse team lost their season opener to visiting SUNY Brockport 11-10 Saturday afternoon. Alfred (0-1, 0-0 Empire 8) fell behind early as Brockport scored the contest's first two goals (12:48, 12:39) and held a 6-4 advantage at the half. The loss comes despite Alfred outshooting Brockport 39-23 (13-4 in the fourth quarter). Junior midfielder Andy Haynes (Rockford, MI/Rockford) led all Saxon scorers with three goals. Freshman midfielder Mike Russo (Mattydale, NY/Cicero-North Syracuse) and senior Jeff Andrews (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) each tallied two goals and an assist. Senior Drew Foster (Pittsford, NY/Pittsford-Sutherland) started in goal for AU, making one save and allowing five goals in 22 minutes. Junior Erick Goins (Colden, NY/St. Francis) played the final 38 minutes and allowed six goals while making four saves. Brockport (1-0, 0-0) had two players score hat tricks: Joe Aquilina and Adam Drypolcher. Garret Allwes played all 60 minutes in goal allowing 10 goals while making 11 saves. Alfred is in action next on Wednesday March 7, and Saturday March 10 as they travel to Myrtle Beach to play DeSales University and Kings College.
