

Work by Alfred University alumnus exhibited at Brooklyn art gallery

BROOKLYN, NY Artwork by Alfred University alumnus Andrew Erdos is included in a group show at The Chimney art gallery in Brooklyn.

The group show at The Chimney is titled “Endnotes” and is based on the book Letters to a Young Poet by Rainer Marie Rilke and the influence of literature on contemporary art. Erdos earned a bachelor of fine arts degree from Alfred University’s School of Art and Design in 2007. He is one of 12 artists whose work is included in the show, which opens Friday, May 4, and runs through June 26.

The gallery has been transformed into a library stocked with influential books from the exhibiting artists’ private collections, displayed alongside their art. Erdos is exhibiting two glass Moon jars one coated in aluminum; the other in coal which he created in Alfred earlier this year.
