

Men's basketball defeats Hartwick

The Alfred University men's basketball team defeated visiting Hartwick 68-54 on Saturday evening at the McLane Center. The Saxons (9-11, 3-6 Empire 8) had a 10 point lead at halftime that they never lost. Alfred outrebounded the Hawks 50-34 and shot 39 percent for the game as Hartwick only shot 31 percent from the field. The Saxons were led by senior guard Quentin Bryant (Buffalo, NY/ Seneca Vocational) who finished the game with a double-double scoring 17 points and grabbing 12 rebounds. Junior forward Dillon Stein (North Huntingdon, PA/ Norwin) added 15 points and seven rebounds for the Saxons. Senior guard Chris LeMasters (Mansfield, Pa/ Mansfield) netted 10 points, seven rebounds and four assists. Hartwick (8-12, 2-7 Empire 8) was paced by Jon Coccoziello who had a game high 20 points and three steals. Tim Kindlon chipped in 12 points for the Hawks. The Saxons are in action next Tuesday, Feb. 7, home vs. St. John Fisher at 8 p.m.
