Marlin Miller Outstanding Senior Awards

The Marlin Miller Outstanding Senior Award has been established to honor Marlin Miller '54, one of Alfred's most generous supporters.

Each year during Honors Convocation, The Alfred University Alumni Association recognizes a graduating man and woman with the Marlin Miller Outstanding Senior Awards. This prestigious award is the University's award for highest all-around accomplishment. The awards shall be given to one man and one woman from the senior class who have contributed most to the life of the University overall and have built positive reputations in the following areas:

1. Scholarship: Nominee must have a minimum GPA of 3.2, attended AU for at least 4 semesters, and must be graduating in May 2008. (The student affairs office will verify GPA).
2. Extracurricular Achievement: nominee should be fully engaged in the extra-curricular life of Alfred University. Involvement with University recognized organizations and activities, specifically in the areas of leadership and advancement of the organization's mission.
3. Personal Character and Conduct: Nominee will have demonstrated high morale character such as integrity, honesty, civility, personal vitality, generosity, and concern for others while at Alfred University.

The Outstanding Senior Man and Outstanding Senior Woman will be required to address their classmates at the May commencement.
