

Saxons even record with 2-0 win in Oswego Tournament consolation match

OSWEGO, NY The Alfred University men's soccer bounced back from a season-opening defeat to shut out SUNY Old Westbury, 2-0, in the consolation match of the SUNY Oswego Tournament Saturday afternoon.

AU (1-1-0) opened the scoring 15:29 into the contest when sophomore midfielder Nicholas Milliman (Randolph, NY/Randolph) scored on an assist from junior defender Rigel Johnson (Little Valley, NY/Cattaraugus-Little Valley). The Saxons struck again just 24 seconds later, when junior forward Jeffrey Thomas (Canandaigua, NY/Canandaigua) scored an unassisted goal.

Freshmen William Badger (Dannemora, NY/Saranac) and Mathew Unick (Warwick, NY/Warwick Valley) split time in goal for Alfred. Bader played the first half and made two saves; Unick played the second half and stopped one shot. Marcelo Guardado made nine saves in goal of Old Westbury.
