

AU women's soccer falls at Ithaca

ITHACA The Alfred University women's soccer team lost their fifth game in a row Tuesday, falling to the host Ithaca Bombers 6-0. Ithaca came out strong, scoring four early goals to put the Saxons (2-5, 0-4 Empire Eight) behind. After scoring the first goal, the Bombers added three more in a span of less than five minutes. Two goals less than a minute apart in the second half put the Saxons away for good. The Saxons were led by senior goaltender Sara Stephens (Wayland/Wayland-Cohocton) who made nine saves while going the distance in the net. Goals for Ithaca (6-0, 3-0 Empire Eight) were scored by six different players. Rachel Thau had a goal and one assist to lead the team. The next game for the Saxons is Saturday, Sept. 22 at 1 p.m. when they travel to Washington College. --30--
