Alfred University softball team takes two from host Fredonia 4/11/07

FREDONIA, NY - The Alfred University softball team swept a doubleheader from host SUNY Fredonia Wednesday afternoon. The Lady Saxons (14-8, 1-1 Empire 8) took the first game, 10-2 in five innings after scoring nine runs in the top of the fifth to erase a 2-1 deficit. AU won the second game, 9-5, again coming back from a 2-1 deficit, this time with a six-run fourth. In the opener, freshman Ilana Price (Wilton, CT/Brien McMahon) improved to 9-2 on the season by allowing two earned runs on four hits and striking out three. Freshman third baseman Jesika LeBarron (Campbell, NY/Corning West) hit her fourth homerun of the season, a two-run shot. Her four round-trippers establish a new school single-season record, which she had shared with four others. Freshman second baseman Jordan Siefer (Sylvania, OH/Sylvania Southview) went 3-for-4 with a pair of doubles and two RBIs; freshman leftfielder Holly Seidewand (Webster, NY/Webster Thomas) had a pair of hits and striking out eight. She helped herself at the plate, going 4-for-5 with a double and three RBIs. Freshman outfielder Mikki Senkow (Elmira Heights, NY/Thomas Edison) went 3-for-4 with a triple and three RBIs.Alfred is in action next on Saturday, April 14, when the Lady Saxons travel to Empire 8 foe Nazareth College for a 1 p.m. doubleheader.
