

Alfred University School of Art and Design instructor to present artist talk

ALFRED, NY Hope Zaccagni, adjunct instructor in the Alfred University School of Art and Design, will give in an artist talk on Saturday, April 28, at 5:30 p.m. in the Cohen Gallery on Main Street in Alfred.

The free talk is sponsored by the School of Art and Design. Zaccagni, an adjunct instructor in the School since 2008, will discuss her exhibition, “Salt and Steel,” which opened at the Cohen Gallery on April 7 and runs through Aug. 3.

The exhibition includes a collection of Zaccagni&s formalist paintings, which are constructed with simple, direct color forms. The work plays on the geometry of her subject matter in space by paying a great deal of attention to the architecture of the painting and to emphasize the visual, rather than emotional, elements of the work.
