

Lady Saxons fall at home to Fisher

ALFRED, NY -- The Alfred University women's basketball team lost to visiting St. John Fisher, 86-55, Tuesday evening. St. John Fisher (18-2, 9-1 Empire 8) built a 54-26 halftime lead, courtesy of 59 percent shooting and a 24-14 rebounding advantage. For the game, the visitors shot 52 percent while Alfred (3-17, 0-10 Empire 8) made 35 percent of its shots. Sophomore forward Meg Coddington (Amherst, NH/Souhegan) paced AU with 10 points and a game-high seven rebounds. Freshman guards Megan Sampsell (Corry, PA/Corry Area) and Logan Polmanteer (Dundee/Dundee) each had eight points, with Sampsell adding four rebounds and a game-high six assists. Senior guard Melissa Buck (Savannah/Clyde-Savannah) and sophomore guard Patricia Affeldt (Horseheads/Horseheads) each scored six points. Junior forward Kelli Nash (Syracuse/West Genesee) led four Fisher players in double figures with a game-high 20 points. Junior center Missy O'Donnell (Elmira/Elmira Free Academy) had 12 points while senior forward Corrine Young (Waterloo/Waterloo) and sophomore forward Melissa Hartman (Middleville/West Canada Valley) each added 10.
