

AU Lax loses to Lycoming, 18-8

WILLIAMSPORT, Pa. The Alfred University men's lacrosse team suffered their third loss of the season as the Lycoming College Warriors defeated the Saxons 18-8 at Lycoming Wednesday afternoon. "Lycoming jumped on us early," AU head coach Preston Chapman said. "We struggled all day with their zone defense." The Saxons (1-3) were never in the game, going down 4-0 at the end of the first quarter and 9-2 at halftime. AU was led by junior Ben Leder (Rockville Centre/Baldwin) who tallied two goals and three assists. Junior Bryan Bacon (Homer/Homer) and senior R.J. Dawson (Northampton, MA/Northampton) each added two goals for the Saxons. Goalie Kevin Kazmierczak (West Seneca/Orchard Park) started the game and had 16 saves in 45 minutes of play. P.J. Campbell (Auburn/Auburn) played the final 15 minutes of the game and made 1 save. The Warriors (5-1) were led by freshman Sang Duong who scored three goals and added four assists. Mike Bonnes added four goals and an assist and Ryan Bergstrom scored three goals and had two assists. Alfred's next game is on Saturday, March 31, at 2 p.m. when the Saxons will travel to Hartwick for their first Empire Eight game of the season.
