## **PCC Mailroom Letter Package Notification**

The PCC Mailroom has a new package tracking system. This system is used to scan the students packages, any overnight letters and all signables from the special carriers.

The PCC Mailroom receives the overnight and special carrier letter size packages for the non-statutory faculty and staff these will now be scanned into the scanning system and an email will be sent directly to the recipient's Alfred email address. The e-mail will list the letter package information and also states that you are required to bring your AU or photo identification to the mailroom when picking up your letter package(s).

You will receive an e-mail for each letter package that you receive. Please do not delete the email until after you pick up your letter package(s).

NOTE: The LARGE packages will still be received by the non-statutory physical plant area.

## **Supervisory Responsibility**

Reminder regarding two key supervisory responsibilities:

- 1. Supervisors must notify Human Resources immediately when any of their staff are absent from work due to their own or a family member's health condition for three consecutive days, or when an ongoing, intermittent absence is requested. This ensures that HR is able to notify the employee of their Family and Medical Leave Act rights, as well as ensure compliance with AU policies.
- 2. Supervisors must ensure that all newly hired student employees have completed an Employment Eligibility Form (I-9) prior to beginning work. Work-study students in possession of a "green card" have already completed an I-9. Other students may or may not have completed an I-9. As the supervisor, you are responsible for ensuring that the student goes to either Financial Aid or Human Resources and completes this federally-mandated documentation.

If you need to verify that an I-9 has been done, please feel free to contact Human Resources.

## **Sexual and Workplace Harassment Training**

She holds a Doctorate in Law from Syracuse University, a Masters degree in Education, and a Bachelors degree in Political Science from Tufts University. ### **ITS Notification Barracuda Filter**

ITS has successfully moved its junk mail filtering to a new application called Barracuda. Part of Barracuda's process is to quarantine e-mails that are tagged as junk mail. Once an e-mail has been quarantined, Barracuda may then send you an e-mail stating that you have an e-mail in quarantine. If you see these notices from Barracuda they are legitimate ITS e-mails and you can open them and follow the instructions.

If you have not received these messages you can also see your quarantined email by going to <a href="http://quarantine.alfred....">http://quarantine.alfred....</a> and typing in your entire e-mail address (username @alfred.edu) and your e-mail password.

If you want to change your quarantine settings, log into <a href="http://quarantine.alfred...">http://quarantine.alfred...</a> and go to Preferences>Quarantine Settings>Quarantine Notification and choose your preference for the Notification Interval. Then click on the Save Changes tab.
