"Circle and Square" at the Cohen Gallery through August 4

Circle and Square, a survey of William Underhill's cast bronze, iron, and aluminum sculptures, features pieces dating from 1960 through his current work.

Underhill's work formally explores the vessel and architectural form. Circle and Square highlights sculpture that demonstrates a sophisticated use of geometry. William Underhill is an emeritus faculty member who taught at NYSCC, School of Art and Design at Alfred University, from 1969 to 1997. During this time he taught sculpture and established the first bronze foundry. Underhill's contributions helped to significantly expand the Division of Sculpture/ Dimensional Studies.

NaturalizeNY: Lottery will provide vouchers for free citizenship

Governor Cuomo's Office for New Americans has launched its second round of NaturalizeNY assisting New Yorkers with the path to citizenship. As a result, New York State will lottery off 1,500 vouchers that cover the cost of applying for U.S. citizenship (worth \$725) as well as all associated legal services. The initiative is called NaturalizeNY <<http://www.NaturalizeNY.org>> <<http://www.NaturalizeNY.org>>.

The lottery is free to enter and open to all citizenship-eligible legal permanent residents (green card holders) residing in New York State who meet certain income requirements. This means that you do not have to be a SUNY affiliate to apply for the lottery. Anyone who meets the eligibility requirements can also register and win. When you register for the lottery, you will be asked a short series of questions to determine your eligibility for the program. All information provided will be stored securely and is strictly confidential.
