

Former science professor dies

Walter I. Lang, 90, of Alfred, who taught at Alfred University from 1945-49, died Sept. 12, 2014 following a long illness. In 1955, Professor Lang joined the Alfred State College faculty where he became chairman of the Physics Department and chairman of the Engineering Science Curriculum, ultimately retiring as professor of civil engineering technology in 1990.

Professor Lang is survived by three sons, Richard S. (Laurie H.) Lang, John (Lisa J.) Lang and Don (Maryann C.) Lang, all of Alfred; one daughter, Rebecca Lang-Graves of Alfred; 11 grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and two nephews, Steve Arnold and David Arnold.

He was a life member and past president of the A.E. Crandall Hook & Ladder Company, Alfred, as well as past president of Allegany County Volunteers Firemen&s Association. He was a member of the Allegany County Chief&s Association.
