### Victoria Vesna presentation

Victoria Vesna is a media artist, professor and chair of the department of Design | Media Arts at the UCLA School of the Arts and Architecture. She is also director of the recently established UCLA Art|Sci center and the UC Digital Arts Research Network.

Her work can be defined as experimental creative research that resides between disciplines and technologies. She explores how communication technologies affect collective behavior and how perceptions of identity shift in relation to scientific innovation. For the past few years she has been collaborating with nano-science pioneer, James Gimzewski, to develop a series of installations that address the impact of nanoscience on culture and consciousness in an experiential manner.
