

Saxons remain lose to visiting Cortland

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's basketball team dropped a 79-58 decision to visiting Cortland, Sunday afternoon at the McLane Center. Despite shooting 45 percent from the floor, Alfred (0-6, 0-1 E8) didn't have a lot of second shot opportunities as the Red Dragons snagged 26 defensive boards. The Saxons also had trouble shooting from the line making just 40 percent (8-20) of their free throws. AU had three players score in double figures with senior guard Garlen Patt (Nelson, PA/Elkland) netting a game-high 15 points and also adding seven rebounds. Junior guard Carl Embury (Perry, NY/Perry) chipped in with 11 points while freshman forward Ellis Walsh added 10 points and four rebounds. Cortland (5-1) was led by Mike Lewis who tallied a double-double, scoring 14 points and pulling down 11 rebounds. Juan Miolan finished with 14 points while Carson Niehoff and Paul Oliver scored 13 and 12 points respectively. Alfred is in action next on Dec. 4, when the Saxons host Geneseo at 8 p.m. at the McLane Center.
