

Lady Saxons defeat Hilbert 3-1

ALFRED, NY- The Alfred University women's soccer team defeated visiting Hilbert College, 3-1 Thursday evening on Merrill Field. Poor weather conditions and a rain delay could not slow the AU offense. Alfred (1-8-1, 0-0-0 E8) notched its first win of the season as the Lady Saxons outshot Hilbert, 24-3 in the contest. Freshman forward Alisha Putney (Fillmore, NY/Fillmore) caught Hilbert's keeper out of position, scoring from 15 yards out, giving the Lady Saxons a 1-0 lead early in the first period. The game was delayed half an hour in the 22nd minute due to lighting in the area. Play resumed and Hilbert knotted the game at 1-1 just before the break (44:42) as Tricia Knight tallied the Hawks only goal. Sophomore forward Alyssa Raykovitz (Andover, NY/Andover) found the back of the net in the 47th minute to put the Lady Saxons on top 2-1. Less than two minutes later, Putney scored her second goal of the game, sealing the victory for Alfred. Freshman Meredith Ragan (Dallas, TX/Science and Engineering Magnet) played 90 minutes in net for Alfred. Hilbert split time between Kelly Goodwin who played 79:15, making 6 saves and Brianna Jerreld who did not face a shot. The Lady Saxons are in action next on Saturday, Sept. 29, at 2 p.m. vs. RPI.
