## 2015 -16 Annual Campus Safety & Fire Report is now available

Dear Alfred University Community,

The Alfred University 2015 -16 Annual Campus Safety & Fire Report is now available and attached. This report is required by federal law to be published by October 1 for the previous calendar year and contains policy statements and crime statistics for our school. The policy statements address Alfred's policies, procedures and programs concerning safety and security, for example, policies for responding to emergency situations and sexual offenses. Three years' worth of statistics are included for certain types of crimes that were reported to have occurred on campus, in or on off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by the school and on public property within or immediately adjacent to the campus. Please note the federal law requires that we count specific crimes by calendar year, not academic year.

You may also request a paper copy from the Office of Public Safety or Dean of Student's Office.

Alfred University stands behind the idea that we all benefit when a greater share of Americans register and vote. This year there will be an important general election on Nov. 8, 2016. If you are not already registered to vote, please consider doing so now.

Alfred University students have a choice of registering and voting right here in Allegany County (if you have been a resident in your present address for at least 30 days before the election) or voting by absentee ballot in your home county or state. The choice is yours, but please plan to register and vote.

You can download the registration form and get more information about voting in New York State, including instructions on how to vote by absentee ballot, at this Web site maintained by the NYS Board of Elections: www.elections.ny.gov.

You can also stop by the Center for Student Involvement to pick up a form for NYS. The Center for Academic Success also has forms available.

Please make sure that to register to vote, you must complete the form, print it out, sign it, and mail it to the county's Board of Elections.
