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### Alumnus, former trustee Joseph Meade Jr. dies

A memorial service will be held at 3 p.m. Friday, Feb. 5, at the Curtiss Museum in Hammondsport for Joseph F. Meade Jr., a 1943 alumnus of Alfred University who served as a trustee from 1980-1986.

Mr. Meade, who was president of Mercury Aircraft in Hammondsport from 1950 until his retirement in 1987, was chairman of the board until the time of his death.

His son, Joseph F. "Bud" Meade III, who followed his father as president of Mercury Aircraft, is a 1974 graduate of AU and served as a trustee from 1999-2002. His grandson, Joseph F. Meade IV, graduated from AU in 2002.
