

AU choral groups to join voices with Pittsburgh University Choir

The Alfred University Chorus and Chamber Singers will join voices with the University of Pittsburgh at Bradford Choir to present "Vespers Solennes de Dominica," by Mozart and the "Lord Nelson Mass," by Haydn, on Wednesday, March 26, 2008, in Bradford, PA, and on Sunday, March 30, 2008, at St. Anne's Church in Hornell, both at 7 p.m. The programs are open to the public free of charge. These works will be accompanied by a small orchestra comprised of members of the Southern Tier Symphony, AU's Director of Bands Christopher Foster on trumpet, and University Carillonneur Laurel Buckwalter on organ. Conducted by Dr. Lee Spear of Bradford, both works will feature three soloists from Alfred: AU Professor of Physics Dr. David Toot, as bass soloist; Alfred State College Associate Professor of Speech William Laubert, as tenor soloist; and AU Professor of Music Dr. Luanne Crosby, as soprano soloist. Leslie Cecchini from Jamestown, NY, will perform as alto soloist.
