

## **AU's Siefer breaks school record for runs**

ALFRED, NY Jordan Siefer (Sylvania, OH/Sylvania Southview), a freshman second baseman on the Alfred University softball team, set a new school record for runs scored in a season. Siefer scored 28 runs this year, which breaks the previous AU single-season record of 26 established in 2000 by former Lady Saxon and 2003 graduate Alicia DeAndrea. Siefer's mark is the fifth new school individual record set this year. Freshman Karen Folts (Penn Yan, NY/Penn Yan) set a new single-game record for RBIs with six in a 13-12 comeback win over Pitt-Bradford on March 29. Freshman pitcher Ilana Price (Wilton, CT/Brien McMahon) established a new single-season record for pitching victories with 16 after winning both ends of a regular season-ending doubleheader at Keystone. She had shared the previous record of 14 with former Lady Saxon pitcher Jenny Rae Skinner (set in 2000). Price's six shutouts shattered the previous single-season record of three set in 2005 by 2006 graduate and current AU assistant Brittany Curran. Jesika LeBarron (Campbell, NY/Corning West) set a new single-season record for homeruns with six, breaking the previous record of three, which had been held by four former players. Her six homers also ties the AU career mark held by 2002 graduate Tara Harwood. Alfred finished the 2007 regular season with a 21-14 record. The 21 wins is a new single-season record. The Lady Saxons were chosen to play in the four-team ECAC Upstate championship tournament, which will be held Saturday and Sunday, May 12 and 13, at RPI. AU is the fourth-seeded team in the double-elimination tournament and will play top-seeded RPI on Saturday at 10 a.m.
