Harland Snodgrass, founder of Media Program, School of Art and Design, passes away 4/12/19

Harland Snodgrass, emeritus professor, Alfred University School of Art and Design, passed away Sunday, March 31, in Chicago, IL. He was 77.

Snodgrass was founder of the Media Program in the School of Art and Design and was an original faculty member of the School's Foundations Program. He served as professor of painting and video arts from 1969-85.

A reception honoring Snodgrass was held at Alfred University in March 2017, celebrating the formal opening of the Time Space Interface Harland Snodgrass Gallery. The dedication of the TSI/Harland Snodgrass Gallery included a multi-media slide presentation by Snodgrass featuring images of students and faculty between 1970 and 1974. The photographic history included images of the construction of Harder Hall and a history of some of the equipment in the Time Space Interface Studio.
