

Second half scoring flurry leads Lady Saxons past Lycoming, 3-0

The Alfred University women's soccer team utilized a swift second half attack to down Lycoming, 3-0, on a rainy Thursday evening at Merrill Field. The Lady Saxons (3-7-1, 0-4-1 Empire Eight) capitalized on Lycoming's sluggish start to second-half play by scoring all three of their goals in the first 11 minutes. Alfred's second-half awakening was highlighted by sophomore forward Amy Hallman (Marblehead, MA/Marblehead), who found the back of the net twice. Freshman forward Emily Packet (Chatham, Chatham) assisted on Hallman's first goal, while junior defender Lauren Hurley (Norfolk, MA/King Phillip) aided in the second. AU's third goal was scored unassisted by freshman midfielder Kellie Speth (Solon, OH/Solon), her second this season. Junior goalkeeper Sara Stephens (Wayland/Wayland-Cohocton) posted her first shutout of the year, denying all three of Lycoming's attempts on goal. Goalie Angela Brewington led Lycoming in the losing effort, grabbing three saves. Alfred will be in action on Sunday, Oct. 8, at 1 p.m. at Vassar College.
