

ALFRED, NY – University's Cohen Art Gallery will host a month-long exhibition of work by alumnus Gary Sczerbaniewicz '95.

"Neil Before Zod" opens Sept. 14 and runs through Oct. 19. An opening reception at the Cohen Gallery will be held Sept. 14 from 6-9 p.m. Sczerbaniewicz earned a B.F.A. in sculpture from Alfred University in 1995 and went on to earn an M.F.A. in visual studies from the University at Buffalo in 2013.

His exhibition is described as a "series of installation works which investigate the interplay between the rational and irrational in three interactive spatial vignettes. The conceptual matrix behind (Neil Before Zod) arises from the true-life relationship between chemist, rocket scientist, and founding member of NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, Jack Whiteside Parsons, and the pulp-science fiction writer and founder of Scientology, L. Ron Hubbard."

The Cohen Gallery is located at 55 North Main Street in Alfred. The exhibition is free and open to the public.
