

Alfred University women's softball team takes one of two in Florida

FT. MYERS, FL. -- The Alfred University softball team won one of two games played Tuesday in Ft. Myers, FL. The Lady Saxons dropped their first game to RPI, 6-5, before bouncing back to knock off St. Joseph's (ME) College, 2-0. Against RPI, Alfred trailed 6-2 entering the bottom of the seventh. The Lady Saxons scored three times and had a runner on third with two outs but couldn't push the tying run across. Freshman shortstop Lauren Mastin (Springwater/Wayland-Cohocton) went 3-for-4 with a double and triple and four RBIs to pace Alfred. Freshman catcher Gretchen Weidner (Eden/Eden) added two hits and scored a pair of runs. Sophomore Brittany Curran (Alfred/Alfred-Almond) pitched 4 1/3 innings in relief and struck out six batters while allowing two runs. In the second game, Curran went the distance on the mound, hurling a one-hit shutout and striking out six. Mastin had a hit, scored a run and had one RBI, while Weider went 1-for-3 with a double and a run scored. Sophomore rightfielder Adrienne Egglinger (Amityville/Amityville) scored Alfred's other run Alfred (2-4, 0-0 Empire 8) is off today. The Lady Saxons conclude their trip with two games Thursday (Merchant Marine Academy, 1 p.m.; Kenyon, 3 p.m.) and Friday (Beloit, 9 a.m.; Wheaton, 3 p.m.).
