Business Office Tip of the Week

Alfred University is exempt from paying sales tax in New York State. Any purchase that is delivered to the University, even from another state, should qualify as tax-exempt.

Remember when you are making a purchase to inform the vendor that your purchase is tax-exempt before the transaction is entered. The tax exemption pertains to all merchandise purchases, travel, restaurants, etc. within New York State. This is applicable whether you are charging direct to the University or using the One Card.

The University is also tax-exempt in New Jersey, Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Florida. All five tax-exempt certificates are available on the Business Office Web site under online forms and at the Business Office in Carnegie Hall.

Free Tax Assistance Available

The Tax Counseling for the Elderly Program (TCE) offers free income tax assistance for low to moderate-income Allegany County senior citizens. Volunteer Counselors are trained and certified to help people who are 60 and over with federal, state and local returns. TCE is sponsored by the Allegany County Office for the Aging in conjunction with AARP and the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

E-filing tax assistance is also available. This service assists filers in completing their tax forms and submits their applications electronically. E-filing is available at the Wellsville David A. Howe Library on Mondays from 10 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m. and at the Belmont Town Hall on Fridays from 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m. during February and March. Appointments are necessary and can be made by calling the Office for the Aging at 585.268.9390 or toll free 1.866.268.9390.
