In preparation for Hot Dog Days events various lots and spaces will be taken off-line.

It is requested that no overnight parking occur on Main Street on Friday night into Saturday afternoon. Also, portions of the Carnegie Lot will be closed to accommodate arts & craft vendors beginning Saturday morning and running until 5 p.m. Saturday.

The McLane Lot will be closed beginning at 6 p.m. Friday remaining closed until midnight Saturday. Portions of the lot will be opened for Saturday's Lacrosse game and then immediately closed again after the game ends.

Parking will also be restricted 100 yards above and below the hairpin turn for fireworks beginning at 8 p.m. Saturday until the fireworks are finished at 10:30 p.m.

### **Excused Time for Support Staff Employees**

Support Staff employees who were not able to leave at their regular time due to the emergency situation on campus Tuesday afternoon, April 8, 2008, may request of their supervisor an equivalent amount of excused time to be used prior to May 31, 2008.
