

## **Acclaimed ceramic artists to present workshops at Alfred University**

Kenneth Ferguson and Josh DeWeese, noted ceramic artists as well as alumni of Alfred University's ceramic art program, will present workshops and lectures on campus Monday and Tuesday (Sept. 9-10.) Ferguson, who received his Master of Fine Arts degree in ceramic art from Alfred University in 1958, and the Archie Bray Foundation, a public non-profit foundation dedicated to the enrichment of the ceramic arts, are this year's recipients of Binns Medals, awarded annually by the School of Art and Design at Alfred University for outstanding contributions to the field of ceramic art. DeWeese, a 1991 alumnus of Alfred, is the current director of the Bray Foundation. Ferguson and DeWeese will conduct workshops from 1:30 to 4 p.m. Monday and Tuesday in the classroom area for junior ceramic art majors in Harder Hall. Both artists will be involved in both workshops. Ferguson will deliver a slide lecture at 4:30 p.m. Monday in Holmes Auditorium, Harder Hall, and DeWeese will present a slide lecture at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, also in Holmes Auditorium.
