

Alfred University men's lacrosse team drops season opener

SYLVAN LAKE, FL The Alfred University men's lacrosse team dropped its 2006 season opener Wednesday afternoon, falling 8-4 to Wittenberg in a game played in Sylvan Lake, FL. The Saxons (0-1, 0-0 Empire 8) led 2-1 after one quarter and 4-3 at halftime before being outscored 5-0 over the final two periods.
