Electronic W2

Did you know that you can receive your W2 (the form that reports an employee's annual wages and the amount of taxes withheld from his or her paycheck) electronically in BannerWeb? This feature will be available late-January.

Advantages of receiving Form W-2 electronically

- -Your W-2 will be available sooner than a printed copy
- -You can reprint a copy of your W-2 anytime during the year
- -No possibility that a Form W-2 might be lost, stolen, delayed or misplaced by the U.S. mail service or by the employee
- -Multiple levels of security protects all information within the BannerWeb system
- -Access can be obtained anytime via the internet-anywhere in the world

If you do not choose to receive your W-2 electronically, a paper copy will be mailed to your home address (current students receive their W-2 in their campus box). Faculty and staff, please ensure the Office of Human Resources has your up-to-date mailing address.

Foreign Language Placement Exam - NEW Administration Procedures Wednesday, January 22, 2020
Perlman Hall Room 105 Language Lab
Time: 6:00 pm

PREREGISTRATION IS REQUIRED

Online Exams will be given in French, German and Spanish.

Students must PREREGISTER by emailing Dr. Furlong (**ffurlong@alfred.edu**) BEFORE 5:30pm on Tuesday, January 21. Entrance to the exam will require a Photo ID. Only students who have preregistered will be admitted to the exam.

Who should (or should not) take a Placement Exam?

- * Students who have taken more than two years of one of these 3 languages in high school and who intend to take the same language at AU should take the exam in that language.
- * Students who are bilingual or native speakers of one of these 3 languages (or who have spoken the language at home) should take the exam in that language.
- * Students who are planning to take French, Spanish or German in college but have NOT studied that language in High School (or spoken it at home) do not need to take an exam. They should start by taking 101 in their chosen language.
- * Students who wish to demonstrate proficiency in a language OTHER THAN Spanish, French, or German should contact Dr. Nancy Furlong about procedures for taking a Placement Exam through another institution.
