Alfred State College has scheduled a test of its outdoor warning sirens on Wednesday, Aug. 31 at 10:10 a.m.

In the event of life threatening emergencies, Alfred State will activate the outdoor warning siren. Any emergency that causes ASC to sound its alarm also has the potential to affect people on our campus. If and when you hear the siren, you should immediately return to a known safe, indoor location.

Information about the emergency, including instructions about what to do, will be communicated via NY Alert. If possible, other methods will be used including WALF broadcasts and postings on entrance doors to academic and residence hall buildings.
