This course covers an overview of the health care system, components of the system (public, private, regulatory, and health care professionals), how we pay for health care, how health care is delivered, health care from the consumer's perspective, and emerging health care issues in the 21st century. Students analyze the impact of events and political decisions on the health care system from both a provider and a consumer point of view. Prerequisite: junior or senior standing.

MBA 600 Topics: US Healthcare Business and Policy

The U.S. health care system operates in an intense, dynamic, and complex environment. As never before, all healthcare consumers - which is all of us - should understand the key components of this system, including its environment and emerging trends. This course covers an overview of the health care system, components of the system (public, private, regulatory, and health care professionals), how we pay for health care, how health care is delivered, health care from the consumer's perspective, and emerging health care issues in the 21st century. Students analyze the impact of events and political decisions on the health care system from both a provider and a consumer point of view, and are required to prepare a comparison between the current US healthcare system and a foreign healthcare system - highlighting the differences and similarities, advantages and disadvantages.
