

Women's Basketball struggles at Elmira

Elmira, NY- The Alfred University women's basketball team was defeated by Elmira College Saturday afternoon, 75-49. With the loss the Saxons record falls to 4-14 (0-7 Empire 8). Alfred shot 28 percent from the floor in the first half as Elmira took a 33-22 lead. However, Elmira would go on to shoot 51 percent in the second half, which helped improve its record to 12-6 (6-1 Empire 8). Alfred, on the other hand, failed to make a 3-point basket the entire game, shooting 0-12. Megan Coddington (Amherst, NH/Souhegan) led the Lady Saxons in scoring with 18 points and pulled down eight rebounds. Colleen Montgomery (Chili, NY/Churchville-Chili) scored 11 points. Melanie Jackson (Andover, NY/Wellsville) grabbed a team high nine rebounds to go with five points and five assists. For Elmira, Sarah Cote scored a game high 23 points including six 3-point baskets to go with five assists in the victory. The Saxons are in action at home Friday, Feb. 3 at 6 p.m.
