More than 200 Alfred University students registered as candidates for possible bone marrow donations at a registration drive organized by Alfred University&s Athletic Department and Saxon Football program.

The registration drive, held Wednesday in the Knight Club, was a partnership between the Athletic Department and Be the Match, an organization that supports research in bone marrow transplants used in the treatment of blood disorders such as leukemia.

Michael Barbin, a Be the Match representative who helped coordinate the Alfred University registration drive, said the number of students who volunteered Wednesday was impressive. "This is one of the highest percentages I&ve ever seen on any college campus," Barbin said.
