

AU women's basketball team falls to Medaille College

ALFRED, NY The Alfred woman's basketball team suffered a defeat at the hands of Medaille College Monday night at the McLane Center 82-50. A total of 34 turnovers hurt the Saxons ability to generate consistent scoring. Alfred shot only 31.6 percent from the floor, while Medaille netted 31 total field goals for a 47 percent output. A 45-30 halftime lead helped Medaille cruise in the second-half. Leading the Saxons (1-3) with 12 points, and three assists was junior Melanie Jackson (Andover, NY/Wellsville). Sophomore Danielle Cooper (Reading, PA/Reading) scored eight points on 4-8 shooting and shared a team high, grabbing seven rebounds. Medaille (2-1) was led by Amanda Baker with 14 points and six rebounds. The Mavericks continued their scoring into the second half with role players. Leading the charge off the bench, Tiffany Collins chipped in eight points and four rebounds. Alfred is in action again at Houghton College on Wednesday, Nov. 28, at 7 p.m.
