

Alfred University hosts Baroque masterpieces concert

A concert of Baroque masterpieces for two violins will be performed by William Hurley of the Community Music School of the Arts, Ithaca, and Dr. Lisa Lantz, associate professor of strings and director of the orchestra at Alfred University, on Sunday, Feb. 18, at 3 p.m. in Susan Howell Hall, on the AU campus. A 2003 graduate of Ithaca College with a master's degree in performance, Hurley is a member of the Albert Consort and the Cayuga Symphony. Both Hurley and Lantz are members of the Binghamton Symphony and the Orchestra of the Southern Finger Lakes. Piano accompanist will be Laurel Buckwalter, Alfred University carillonneur. Music of J.S. Bach, Handel, Vivaldi and Tartini will be featured as well as an "info-chat" about the composers' compositions and their influence on the violin world through the ages. The concert, funded by the David and Elizabeth Miller Performing Arts Fund, is free and open to the public.
